Online Training for Foodservice Efficiency

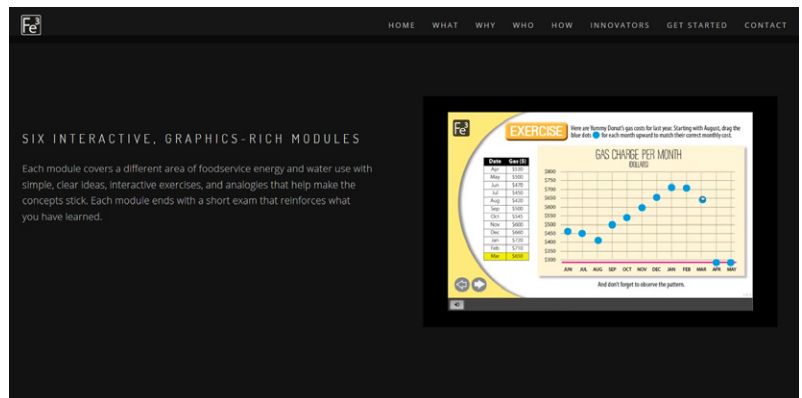
Training food service professionals to treat energy and water like other commodities and giving them the skills to manage their utilities, like they manage food costs, has the potential to return those billions back to the bottom line.

After passing all six modules, the student receives an Fe3 Certification that can be used as a professional credential.

Fe3 is aimed at commercial kitchen designers, culinary and hospitality educators, foodservice operators, and utility representatives who want to learn more about customers' energy challenges.

More than 500 people are Fe3-certified and a major university is in the process of adding Fe3 to its hospitality curriculum.
